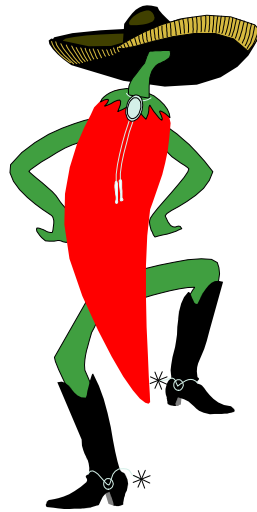

StoryCorps in Gainesville

StoryCorps, the national oral history project will be recording the stories of the Gainesville community in February 2014. The StoryCorps MobileBooth will be located at the Alachua County Library - downtown branch.

Participants record a 40-minute conversation with a friend or loved one and receive a broadcast quality CD of their recording. With consent the recording will be archived with the Library of Congress Folklife Archive and a small percentage are edited for broadcast on National Public Radio's Morning Edition.

Public reservations are made on a first-come, first-serve basis by logging onto our website storycorps.org/reservations or by calling our 24 hour reservations line 800-850-4406. The interview is free.

StoryCorps is a nonprofit whose mission is to offer people of all backgrounds and beliefs the opportunity to record, share, and preserve the stories of our lives for future generations of families to hear. StoryCorps is eager to record and archive the stories of the Gainesville LGBT community.
