Recent PCCNCF Events

During June and July, the LGBT+ community came together for events that occurred as a result of the mass shooting at Orlando's Pulse club. When we awoke Sunday, June 12th, to the horrific news many of us felt the need to be with family, to grieve and try and make some sense of this. PCCNCF held a community gathering Sunday afternoon, where counselors from the Alachua County Crisis Center were on hand to offer support and crisis counseling when needed. 40 or 50 people came through our doors to sit and meet for a short time or longer.

The next evening over 1,000 folks packed the Gainesville City Hall courtyard for a vigil organized by the Pride Community Center. With our community partners Trinity MCC, Stonewall Democrats, HRCNCF, Equality Florida, and United Church of Gainesville, we joined together and honored the 49 victims of the deadliest mass shooting in recent US history.

On July 11th, more than 25 people attended a meeting where GPD Chief Jones introduced 3 officers as liaisons to our community. The meeting's goal was to better communicate with Gainesville's LGBT+ and minority communities and was the first of many such meetings to be announced. The participants, both community members and police officers, felt the exchange was a good start.

PCCNCF had been planning the Anniversary Party to celebrate the 2015 US Supreme Court Same Sex Marriage decision since the beginning of the year. With the shooting at the Pulse club just 12 days before June 24th, we had to decide whether to hold the event or not. After extensive heartfelt discussion we chose to continue with a scaled back program. It was understood that some felt it was too soon to attend anything that felt like a celebration while others felt we must recognize our victories even while we mourned our dead. There was a good presence of public officials showing support for the LGBT+ community and many citizens in attendance. We will continue to celebrate our victories and honor our lost latinx community members. Repercussions from the mass shooting at the Pulse club will be felt for many years to come.
