



PCCNCF Selects Theme and Logo to Honor Stonewall 45

In February, PCCNCF selected “Pride is Family” as the 2014 theme, but we now realize that this was a very difficult theme to create a logo for. We only received submissions from two artists and those did not capture the essence of the theme. As we evaluated the submissions, the PCCNCF Board collectively realized that our selection of this theme created a significant difficulty for the creation of a logo. We would like to thank the artists for their submissions and apologize for our error in selecting this difficult theme.



We then stepped back and re-evaluated the situation regarding the theme. We realized that 2014 is the 45th year since the Stonewall Riots and InterPride, the international coalition of Pride organizers, had recognized that significant anniversary in their theme selection. We decided to incorporate that anniversary into our annual theme and logo. With some collective work by the Board and with significant graphics assistance from Vertigo Moody we came up with the new logo you see here.

We hope the entire community will acknowledge the amazing strides that have been taken since that June night in 1969, and in particular recognize the advances that have been made in Gainesville and North Central Florida. We also envisage that the selection of this theme will provide the opportunity to educate those folks in our community who don’t know about Stonewall and its importance in American history. Finally we want everyone to know that the efforts of LGBT activists will continue until all human beings, regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity, are treated with dignity and true equality.
